These include washing hands before and aftercare with disinfectant hand soap, gloves and facemasks, chemical disinfection of countertops and surfaces, sterilization of all equipment before every use, and disposable materials.

This includes a hands-free instrument washer, a quick turnaround autoclave, a device that kills bacteria and viruses by steam, heat, and pressure and keeps our instruments like new.
